



## Healthcare.gov, Health Insurance Marketplace Reopens February 15, 2021 – May 15, 2021

**Uninsured Arizonans can enroll in no cost and low-cost health coverage.**

The Health Insurance Marketplace (Healthcare.gov) is being reopened from **February 15 until May 15** because of the ongoing pandemic to help uninsured people gain comprehensive health coverage.

- Bilingual local help is available across Arizona from unbiased Health Application Assistants. Make an appointment today if you want help understanding your options. Call 800.377.3536 or go to [www.coveraz.org](http://www.coveraz.org) to ask your questions or make an appointment. Application Assistants are not salespeople. They work for local nonprofit groups and help you understand your options and fill out complicated enrollment forms.
- Do it yourself? Go to [www.healthcare.gov](http://www.healthcare.gov) or [www.cuidadodesalud.gov](http://www.cuidadodesalud.gov) to enroll on your own. Or call 800.318.2596 to access English and more than 50 other languages.
- Window shopping on Healthcare.gov is also available, which allows consumers to “look before they buy”, [www.healthcare.gov/see-plans](http://www.healthcare.gov/see-plans). Without entering your name or anything other than zip code, estimated 2021 income and family size you can see what plans are available and if you qualify for financial help. About 9 out of 10 shoppers qualify for financial help.
- Name          ,           Title          ,           Organization          , explained, “Arizona has nearly 700,000 uninsured Arizonans who can qualify for AHCCCS (234,000 eligible) or Marketplace (440,000 eligible) coverage. That’s more people than live in Tucson, Yuma, Flagstaff and Kingman combined who could take advantage of this opportunity. And, Arizona has a “no-wrong-door” policy so if you apply for AHCCCS and earn too much, your application will be sent to HealthCare.gov and if you apply through HealthCare.gov and appear to be AHCCCS eligible, your application is rerouted to AHCCCS.
